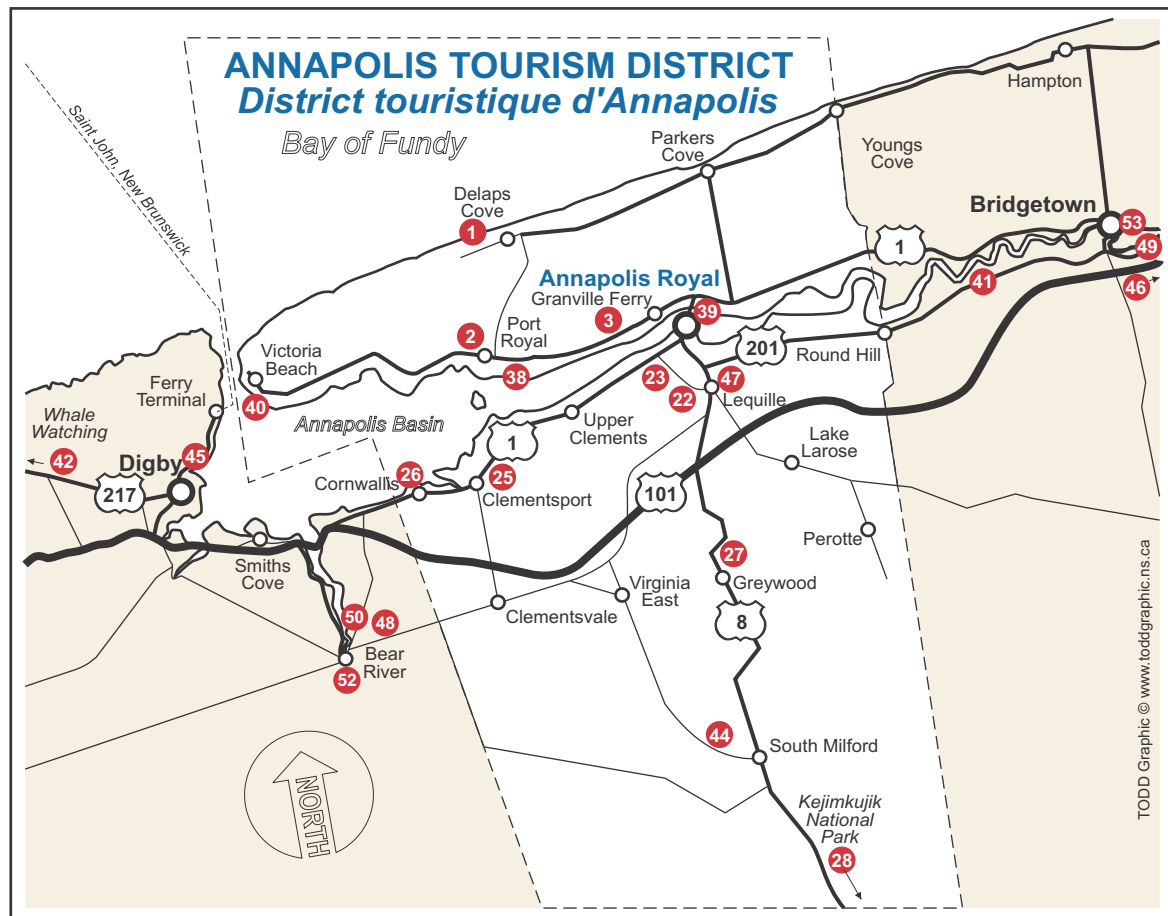

SCENIC DRIVES, TOURS, ACTIVITIES

Historic & Scenic Circle Tour including the Bay of Fundy and Bridgetown

From Annapolis Royal go through Granville Ferry to visit North Hills Museum (3) Melanson Settlement National Historic Site (38) Port-Royal National Historic Site (2) and Victoria Beach (40). Come back towards Port-Royal then cross the North Mountain to Delaps Cove Wilderness Trail (1) and the Bay of Fundy shore. Explore Parker's Cove, Young's Cove and the beach at Hampton, then continue South to Bridgetown. Return to Annapolis Royal via Highway 1 if you want to stop at Kayak Annapolis Royal (39), or come back on the 201 if you plan to visit the Tupperville School Museum (41). Highway 1 to Fort View Golf Course & Whale Watching

Fort View Golf Course (23) is located on Highway 1, only about 2 minutes from the Annapolis Royal stoplight en route to Digby. Visit Old St. Edward's Loyalist Church (25) in Clementsport and continue on for Whale Watching expeditions (42) with Ocean Explorations in Tiverton (approx. 1:30 min. from Annapolis) and Mariner Cruises in Westport on Brier Island (2 hours from Annapolis). If you're going whale watching be sure to allow plenty of time since ferry schedules are involved. Refer to p. 6 for whale watching and p. 8 and 9 for other area attractions.

Explore Digby and the Bay of Fundy with Gael Tours

Travel West on Highway 101 or Highway 1 to discover the streetscapes and seascapes of Digby and the Bay of Fundy with Gael Tours, and enjoy one of their memorable Fundy coast experiences (45). www.gaeltours.ca

Route 8 to Raven Haven Beach & Kejimikujik National Park & National Historic Site


Take Route 8 towards Kejimikujik National Park. The Grist Mill (22), on the Dugway Road in Lequille, is located only about 5 minutes from the Annapolis Royal stoplight. Continue on Route 8 towards Kejimikujik (28), only 45 minutes from Annapolis Royal. See page 15 for some of the special events happening at Keji. Be sure to also stop and enjoy Mickey Hill Pocket Wilderness (27) and Raven Haven Beachside Family Park (44). For more information on these attractions see page 17.

Artists' Studios/Galleries, Champlain's Trail & Annapolis Basin Conference Centre

See p.16 for a self tour of Art Galleries & Artists' Studios. The Map on p. 11 shows their locations in Annapolis Royal. Dawn Oman's Art Gallery (53) in Bridgetown is 20 min. from Annapolis. Blue Mind Gallery (52) in Bear River is about 23 min. away. Champlain's Cheer Trail locations (p.15) include Still Fired Distilleries (47) on Hwy 8 in Lequille, 3 min. from Annapolis; Lunn's Mill Beer Company (49) in Lawrencetown via Hwy 201, 28 min. away; Casa Nova Fine Beverages (48) in Bear River East, 20 min; and Bear River Vineyards (50), 23 min away. For a scenic and artistic spot to host a conference, reunion, wedding or retreat, check out beautiful Annapolis Basin Conference Centre (26) on Hwy. 1.

Oaklawn Farm Zoo

To visit Oaklawn Farm Zoo (46), travel East on Hwy 101. Take exit # 16, turn right and follow the blue zoo signs.
