




It measures about 18' in length and 8' in height and was a labor of love over 4 years in the making. Settled by the French in 1605, 2 years before Jamestown, 3 years before the founding of Quebec and 15 years before Pilgrims landed, Annapolis Royal, the cradle of our nation, is also one of the oldest permanent European settlements in North America. 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
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
